The B2B advantage

Linking complementary services through the Internet is the way of the future. Lisa May reports.

THE INTERNET, while disastrous for some, has proven a boon for many companies, particularly in the world of e-commerce.

Even though many companies are still on a Net learning curve as a result of the April 2000 boom and bust, one of the major advantages of being a cyberspace player is the Internet's capacity to remove 'the tyranny of distance' for users and suppliers.

According to the CFO of Internet services provider Icon Medialab Asia, Scottish-born Mark Forsyth, the future of the Internet is in extranets and Web-enabled software solutions.

Forsyth notes those sites which rely solely on advertising have either gone broke or are quickly heading that way. But he doesn't think e-commerce is any different to other businesses.

"It's just another view of how you get to your customers or they get to you or you get to your suppliers or talk to your staff," he says.

"People get confused with the technology that's behind it and that's not how I approach it. How I approach it is the business opportunities that it presents to companies and individuals – that's what interested me in it."

Forsyth believes Australian companies are dragging the chain in exploiting the potential of the Internet in such areas as Customer Relationship Management and strategic alliances.

"Australian companies have not yet taken it to the next step ... a good example would be ... luxury cars – BMW and Mercedes. What's to stop BMW and Mercedes becoming financial institutions? ... They've got the data on their clients. They know how expensive the cars were so they know their income bracket and they know where they live.

"They know everything about them so what's to stop them teaming up with a bank or developing their own front-end portal?"

Forsyth points out that Australian banks could also set up online banks in markets in which they have a licence.

He uses the example of Icon Medialab client www.fsharpbank.com, which is owned by the Bank of Ireland but is based in the Isle of Man and targets high net worth individuals.

"What they've done is develop a portal which is legally-based in the Isle of Man but a lot of the management and control and data processing is sitting in Ireland."

In Australia, companies are now realising there are significant cost savings available by becoming an e-business – but most are slow on the uptake.

In the banking industry for instance, Australia's financial institutions are increasingly using technology to streamline their business processes, increase efficiencies and deliver services to customers online.

Westpac appears to have stolen a march on its rivals in becoming an e-business by implementing the Oracle E-Business suite across its Australian operations.

Oracle's E-Business Suite handles the bank's high-volume of financial transactions and improves the performance and manageability of its accounting processes.

Oracle Australia recently completed a deal with Westpac to go 'live' on the Oracle E-Business Suite for its Australian operations,
